No. 106-506) and the implementation agreement for the Southern Nevada Public Land Management Act of 1998 (SNPLMA) (Pub. L. No. 105-263) as essential in providing advice and recommendations to the Partnership in implementing both acts and the Federal share of the Environmental Improvement Program at Lake

Tahoe.
