20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

The Advisory Committee fulfills two functions. First, as required by Section 3(d)(4) of the Export-Import Bank Act of 1945, as amended, the Advisory Committee submitted its views on the Annual Competitiveness Report to Congress regarding the Bank's ability to provide competitive financing to neutralize the officially supported export financing provided by EXIM Bank's OECD counterparts. In addition, the Advisory Committee Members fulfill their advisory role by participating in quarterly meetings designed to solicit ideas, opinions and recommendations from the members on topics affecting the programs of EXIM Bank.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

Advisory Committee Membership is balanced as mandated by law and directed by committee charter which requires 17 members who represent the following sectors: labor, commerce, finance, agriculture, small business, Environment, government, textiles and manufacturing.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The EXIM Bank Advisory Committee meets once each quarter (or 4 times per year). Note: Due to a lack of an EXIM board quorum, there were no Advisory Committee meetings held in FY17.

The Advisory Committee is Congressionally mandated pursuant to Section 3(d) of the Export-Import Bank Act of 1945, as amended.

20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

Due to a lack of board quorum, there were no advisory committee meetings held.

There are no costs and no members because member appointments are postponed due to the lack of a quorum on the EXIM Board of Directors, thus prohibiting the Bank to continue its Advisory Committee functions. Without a Board to approve new members, Advisory Committee activities were postponed.
