20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

In FY 2023, the Regulations and Procedures
Technical Advisory Committee (RPTAC or
Committee) continued to work primarily through its
existing work groups. The current work groups
are: Compliance and Enforcement Work Group;
the Computing, Encryption, Data Security Work
Group; the Plurilateral Controls, Sanctions Work
Group; U.S. Person, End-user, End-use Controls
Work Group; and the Supply Chain Work Group.
The work of the Committee during FY 2023
included providing comments on pending and

proposed regulations and the Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS) initiatives, advancing proposals for improving the efficiency and effectiveness of various procedures, and meeting with members of the BIS management team to provide briefings on issues before the RPTAC. In FY 2023, the RPTAC's key accomplishments included review, comments and recommendations concerning the following regulations, topics, and initiatives (letters and e-mails to US Government officials referenced where applicable): RIN 0694-AJ23 Export Controls on Semiconductor Manufacturing Items; Entity List Modifications (August 2023), status is pending. RIN 0694-AI35 Proposed Amendments to End-Use and End-User Based Export Controls, Including U.S. Persons Activities Controls and Human Rights Controls (March 2023), status is pending. RIN 0694-AJ32 Proposed Enhancements and Simplification of License Exception Strategic Trade Authorization (STA). RIN 0694-AJ36 Revisions of Temporary Denial Order Provisions to Allow for Extended Renewals in Certain Circumstances. RIN 0694-AJ29 Allied Governments Favorable Treatment: Revisions to Certain Australia Group Controls; Revisions to Certain Crime Control and Detection Controls. RIN 0694–Al66 Revisions to the Export Administration Regulations Based on 2018, 2019, 2021, and 2022 Missile Technology Control Regime Plenary Agreements; Revisions to License Exception Eligibility. RIN 0694-Al94- Implementation of Additional Export Controls: Certain Advanced Computing Items and Semiconductor Manufacturing Items; Supercomputer and Semiconductor End Use; Updates to the Controls and Corrections (March 2023), still pending. RIN 0694-AI84 -Section 1758 Technology Export Controls on Instruments for the Automated Chemical Synthesis of Peptides. RIN 0694-AI94

Implementation of Additional Export Controls: Certain Advanced Computing and Semiconductor Manufacturing Items; Supercomputer and Semiconductor End Use; Entity List Modification; Updates to the Controls to Add Macau. In FY 2024, the Committee will focus on continuation of the established work groups and their respective initiatives. The Committee and Work groups will continue to meet between the full committee meetings as needed in order to further their objectives and to provide timely comments, recommendations, and proposals to BIS. The Committee will continue to provide timely input on BIS draft regulations and initiatives, as well as RPTAC proposals on matters of interest to industry.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

The RPTAC is composed of industry representatives, and U.S. Government agencies with specific technical or export control expertise in the area of export control administration. Individuals from large and small firms throughout the U.S. are represented on the Committee.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The RPTAC met four times in FY 2023. The meetings allow the RPTAC to advise on the implementation and administration of current export control initiatives.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

The RPTAC provides the Department with technically qualified individuals possessing a broad range of expertise in the area of export control administration. There are no other known

sources within the Government that reflect this depth and range of expertise.

20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

Closed sessions are held to allow for discussion of information classified for reasons of national security, information the premature disclosure of which would be likely to significantly frustrate implementation of a proposed agency action, or information of a commercial or financial nature that is privileged or confidential.
