20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

At the current time, the PECSEA has no members and is not accomplishing its purpose because it is awaiting the appointment of new members to the re-established committee.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

The PECSEA is composed of high-level industry and Government members representing diverse points of view on the concerns of the business community. PECSEA industry representatives are selected from firms producing a broad range of commodities presently controlled for national security, foreign policy, and short supply reasons or that are proposed for such controls. The range of expertise and points of view represented on the PECSEA enable it to successfully address these goals.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The Subcommittee provides the Government with direct input from representatives of the broad range of industries that are directly affected by export controls. The PECSEA was re-established on 1/29/2024.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

The PECSEA is a high-level industry forum that advises the Department on the impact its export control policies have on the nation's economic security. The functions of the PECSEA cannot be performed by the Department nor by any existing advisory committee or Federal agency. The PECSEA provides industry a voice at the highest levels of Government on export control issues, and it provides the Government with expertise from within industry that otherwise would be unavailable.

20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

Closed sessions are held to allow for discussion of information classified for national defense or foreign policy reasons.
