20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

The Commission, pursuant to section 942(a) of the FY 2017 NDAA, shall examine and make recommendations with respect to the national defense strategy of the United States. Pursuant to section 942(c) of the FY 2017 NDAA, the Commission shall: a) Review the current national defense strategy of the United States, including the assumptions, missions, force posture and structure, and strategic and military risks associated with the strategy and, b) Conduct a comprehensive assessment of the strategic

environment, the threats to the United States, the size and shape of the force, readiness of the force, the posture and capabilities of the force, the allocation of resources, and strategic and military risks in order to provide recommendations on the national defense strategy for the United States.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

Pursuant to section 942(b)(1) of the FY 2017 NDAA, the Commission shall be composed of 12 members appointed as follows: a) Three members appointed by the chair of the Committee on Armed Services of the House of Representatives. b) Three members appointed by the ranking minority member of the Committee on Armed Services of the House of Representatives. c) Three members appointed by the chair of the Committee on Armed Services of the Senate. d) Three members appointed by the ranking minority member of the Committee on Armed Services of the Senate.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The estimated number of Commission meetings is at least two per year.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

Section 942(a) of the FY 2017 NDAA, established the Commission, a non-discretionary Committee that report to the President, the Secretary of Defense, the Committee on Armed Services of the House of Representatives, and the Committee on Armed Services of the Senate through the Under Secretary of Defense for Policy.
