The committee consists of the following: two USGS ex officio members (Chair/Vice Chair), four Federal ex-officio members, two State representatives, two private-sector representatives, and one academic representative, which is mandated by its law.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The committee meets at least annually. The Chair may call other meetings of the Advisory Committee as deemed appropriate. Meetings are called to improve coordination among Federal, State, academic, and private sector institutions involved in geologic mapping and the earth sciences.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

No other organization or group exists that provides the breadth of Federal, State, private-sector, and academic membership.

20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

All meetings of the Advisory Committee are open.

21. Remarks

No meetings were held in Fiscal Year 2023 pending charter renewal and hiring of new permanent Program Coordinator (DFO) for the National Cooperative Geologic Mapping Program. The charter renewal package is in process. Once the charter has been renewed, the DFO will proceed with soliciting nominations for membership.
