consultant hired by the National Historic
Landmarks Program (National Park Service,

Department of the Interior). These materials include: an inventory of Cold War sites; a bibliography of Cold War history; a historic context for a theme study; and a Cold War interpretative handbook.

Legislation requires that committee members include three experts in Cold War history; one expert in twentieth-century American history; two experts in preservation; and three members of the general public.
