## 20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

The GAC is an advisory body to the Attorney General and the Assistant Attorney General, Office of Justice Programs (OJP) created to support broad-scale exchange of justice information. The GAC consists of key officials from local, state, tribal, federal, and other justice-interested entities that work to support public safety. The GAC seeks to improve the administration of justice and protect the nation's public by promoting practices and technologies for the secure sharing of justice information. The duties of the GAC are to carry out the objectives

listed in the section of the Charter entitled Objective and Scope of Activity. The overall advisory process and structure will include representatives from local, state, tribal, and federal agencies. The GAC also appoints subject matter working groups, with DOJ approval. The working groups will research and prepare recommendations to the GAC. These recommendations will be voted on by the GAC and, if approved, forwarded to OJP for review.

## 20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

The membership includes representatives from local, state, tribal, and federal agencies. Balanced membership is achieved by nominating and selecting members with subject-matter expertise and different points of view on such topics as improving frameworks to support national justice information sharing, protecting privacy and information quality standards, and enhancing security guidelines and technologies for trusted information sharing.

## 20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

This committee is established by the Attorney General to ensure appropriate input from local, state, tribal, and federal agencies regarding information sharing and integration within the justice community.

The Global Justice Information Sharing Initiative (Global) serves as a Federal Advisory Committee (FAC) and advises the U.S. Attorney General on justice information sharing and integration initiatives. Global was created to support the broad scale exchange of pertinent justice and public safety information. It promotes standards-based electronic information exchange to provide the justice community with timely, accurate, complete, and accessible information in a secure and trusted environment. DOJ's Global Advisory Committee continues to provide recommendations, based upon subject matter expertise from the field, to support the Department's mission concerning Justice Information Sharing activities.
