20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

The Advisory Council discusses BTS programs and services during its meetings and produces a letter report to the Administrator summarizing key findings and consensus views of the group. Individual members also provide comments on specific topics that are not of general interest to all ACTS members.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

The statute requires that membership on the Advisory Council shall consist of 9-11 members, one of whom must have expertise in economics and one who must have expertise in statistics, and all of them must have expertise in transportation statistics and analysis. These members represent the broad interests of State and local governments, the private and nonprofit research sectors, and the academic community in the fields of transportation, statistics, geography, and economics. BTS anticipates approval of a slate of appointments and reappointments in early 2016 to bring ACTS to full strength. No activity in Fy17 and FY18.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

No meetings were held in FY18. The Council usually meets twice a year. Past committees place greater emphasis on discussion of strategic issues effecting BTS rather than on briefings. Member discussion has provided valuable feedback and insights for BTS leadership.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

In the past several of the members are very senior professionals who have substantial demands on their time. Membership on the Council has proven to be the most effective way of capturing their attention for periods long enough to provide effective advice.
