## 20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

The Medical Review Board is composed of five members each appointed by the Secretary on the recommendation of the FMCSA Administrator. The members are special government employees. Each member is appointed for a 2-year term, with eligibility for reappointment.

# 20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

The FMCSA selects the five members from licensed physicians through out the United States, according to the statutory requirements.

## 20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The MRB meets 1-2 times per year. Meetings are open to the public. Approximately every other year, the MRB holds a joint meeting with the Motor Carrier Safety Advisory Committee (MCSAC) on a topic of mutual interest. The DFO may call special meetings as necessary.

### 20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

The Safe, Accountable, Flexible, and Efficient Transportation Equity Act of 2005, Section 4116, requires FMCSA, with the advice of the Medical Review Board to provide recommendations on medical standards and guidelines for the physical qualifications of operators of commercial motor vehicles and medical research.

### 20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

The two meetings in FY2023 have been closed by the Secretary's approval as they related to the MRB considering questions for the recertification examinations for medical examiners on FMCSA's National Registry of Certified Medical Examiners. These are the only two MRB meetings that have ever been closed.

#### **Number of Recommendations Comments**

MRB has provided recommendations to FMCSA since November 2006 on a variety of topics concerning FMCSA's medical standards and medical certification of commercial motor vehicle drivers. MRB completed its review of the recommended revisions to FMCSA's medical examiners handbook, completed a form recommended for medical examiners to evaluate non-insulin dependent driver with diabetes mellitus, and recommended changes to the Agency for its vision standard for CMV drivers, which is now a soon to be final rule. Additionally, MRB reviewed a recall of CPAP machines and recommended standards for drivers already being treated for obstructive sleep apnea and the MEs who evaluate them for compliance with our medical standards.
