The Center for Substance Abuse Prevention · The Center for Mental Health Services · The Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention and· The Office of National Drug Control Policy. The Secretary appointed the Committee's remaining members (up to eleven) from organizations or entities working in the following areas -- state and local government representatives, and researchers and expert practitioners in the fields of school- and community-based substance abuse and violence prevention.
