## 20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

Section 492 of the PHS Act states that "The Secretary...shall by regulation require appropriate technical and scientific peer review of -- (A) applications...; and (B) biomedical and behavioral research and development contracts." This committee is composed of recognized biomedical and behavioral research authorities who represent the forefront of research and technical knowledge and who provide first-level merit review of highly scientific and technical research funding applications and proposals, including but not limited to grant and cooperative agreement

applications and contract proposals for research projects and for research and training activities in areas relevant to biophysics of neural systems, cellular and molecular biology of glia, cellular and molecular biology of neurodegeneration, molecular neuropharmacology, neurodifferentiation, plasticity, and regeneration, neurogenesis and cell fate neural oxidative metabolism and death, neurotransporters, receptors, and calcium signaling, and synapses, cytoskeleton and trafficking. During this reporting period the committee reviewed 1,414 applications requesting \$2,088,777,488.00

## 20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

The members of this committee are authorities knowledgeable in the various disciplines and fields relating to biophysics of neural systems, cellular and molecular biology of glia, cellular and molecular biology of neurodegeneration, molecular neuropharmacology, neurodifferentiation, plasticity, and regeneration, neurogenesis and cell fate neural oxidative metabolism and death, neurotransporters, receptors, and calcium signaling, and synapses, cytoskeleton and trafficking.

## 20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The committee held 22 meetings during this reporting period.

## 20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

This committee is composed of recognized biomedical and/or behavioral research authorities who represent the forefront of research and technical knowledge and who provide first-level merit review of highly scientific and technical research grant applications and contract proposals. These evaluations and recommendations can not be obtained from other sources because the specialized, complex nature of the applications and proposals requires a unique balance and breadth of expertise not available on the NIH staff or from other established sources.

## 20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

The meetings of the committee were closed to the public for the review of grant applications. Sections 552b(c)(4) and 552b(c)(6) of the Government in the Sunshine Act permit the closing of meetings where discussion could reveal confidential trade secrets or commercial property such as patentable material and personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

The NIH dual peer review system is mandated by statute in accordance with section 492 of the Public Health Service Act. The charge to this committee is to determine scientific and technical merit of the individual grants or contracts. These recommendations are forwarded to Federal officials who generally accept the committee's recommendations and favorable applications are then forwarded for the second level of review performed by Institute and Center (IC) National Advisory Councils or Boards. Only applications that are favorably recommended by both the initial peer review committee and the Advisory Council may be funded.

It is these Institutes or Centers and their advisory councils that make funding decisions.NIH Peer Review Committees are involved in the initial review of research grant applications. The NIH dual peer review system is mandated by statute in accordance with section 492 of the Public Health Service Act. The charge to this committee is to determine scientific and technical merit of the individual grants or contracts. These recommendations are forwarded to Federal officials who generally accept the committee's recommendations and favorable applications are then forwarded for the second level of review performed by Institute and Center (IC) National Advisory Councils or Boards. Only applications that are favorably recommended by both the initial peer review committee and the Advisory Council may be funded.
