20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

Section 492 of the PHS Act states that The Secretary...shall by regulation require appropriate technical and scientific peer review of -- (A) applications...; and (B) biomedical and behavioral research and development contracts. This committee is composed of recognized biomedical and behavioral research authorities who represent

the forefront of research and technical knowledge and who provide first-level merit review of highly scientific and technical funding applications and proposals, including but not limited to grant and cooperative agreement applications and contract proposals for research projects and for research and training activities in the in areas relevant to (1) neural basis of emotional and motivational behavior; (2) regulation of function, at the systems level, by neuroendocrine and neuroimmune influences; (3) the analysis of neural system function under various behavioral states, e.g., sleep and hibernation; (4) the maintenance of homeostasis by the autonomic nervous system; (5) chemosensation, hearing, balance, touch and somatosensation; (6) motor-system and sensory motor integration; (7) the integration of multisensory information; (8) the development and alteration of memory and other cognitive processes that accompany aging; (9) computational and theoretical models of cognitive processes; (10) mechanisms that underlie neural coding of complex stimuli; (11) attention and its effect on information processing in the nervous system; (12) those portions of the eye, brain, and intraocular muscle system that serve visual sensation; and (13) neuropharmacological effects of alcohol and toxicants. During this reporting period the committee reviewed 2,058 applications requesting \$2,807,519,551.00.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

The members of this committee are authorities knowledgeable in the various disciplines and fields relating to (1) neural basis of emotional and motivational behavior; (2) regulation of function, at the systems level, by neuroendocrine and neuroimmune influences; (3) the analysis of neural

system function under various behavioral states, e.g., sleep and hibernation; (4) the maintenance of homeostasis by the autonomic nervous system; (5) chemosensation, hearing, balance, touch and somatosensation; (6) motor-system and sensory motor integration; (7) the integration of multisensory information; (8) the development and alteration of memory and other cognitive processes that accompany aging; (9) computational and theoretical models of cognitive processes; (10) mechanisms that underlie neural coding of complex stimuli; (11) attention and its effect on information processing in the nervous system; (12) those portions of the eye, brain, and intraocular muscle system that serve visual sensation; and (13) neuropharmacological effects of alcohol and toxicants.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The committee held 27 meetings during this reporting period.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

This committee is composed of recognized biomedical and/or behavioral research authorities who represent the forefront of research and technical knowledge and who provide first-level merit review of highly scientific and technical research grant applications and contract proposals. These evaluations and recommendations cannot be obtained from other sources because the specialized, complex nature of the applications and proposals requires a unique balance and breadth of expertise not available on the NIH staff or from other established sources.

20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

The meetings of the committee were closed to the public for the review of grant applications. Sections 552b(c)(4) and 552b(c)(6) of the Government in the Sunshine Act permit the closing of meetings where discussion could reveal confidential trade secrets or commercial property such as patentable material and personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

21. Remarks

This committee did not produce any public reports during the fiscal year. Due to the assignment of responsibilities within the Center, the roles of the committee designated federal official and committee decision maker are filled by the same individual. Dr. Colleen Le Prell was reassigned to the role of chairperson during the fiscal year. Drs. Kirsteen Browning, Richard Mooney and W. Martin Usrey were reappointed to the role of chairperson through 6/30/2026. The following members' terms ended early: Asaf Keller (11/13/2023), Daniela Menichella (4/16/2024), Kayode Williams (6/30/2024) and Ralph Mistlberger (8/03/2024). Due to the larger number of members serving on this committee, NIH staff are unable to provide additional information on Occupation or Affiliation. Additional information on an individual's affiliation may be obtained by contacting the designated federal officer listed in this report. In general, initial/integrated review group (IRG) members serve up to six years, which is documented in the Members list. Temporary members are individuals recruited based on expertise needed for each meeting. Some temporary members may attend one meeting only

Narrative Description

The mission of the Center for Scientific Review is to provide the funding Institutes and Centers of NIH with the scientific and technical merit of research grant applications submitted to the NIH. It is these Institutes or Centers and their advisory councils that make funding decisions. NIH Peer Review Committees are involved in the initial review of research grant applications. The NIH dual peer review system is mandated by statute in accordance with section 492 of the Public Health Service Act. NIH's mission is to seek fundamental knowledge about the nature and behavior of living systems and the application of that knowledge to enhance health, lengthen life, and reduce illness and disability. NIH works toward that mission by supporting the research of non-Federal

scientists in universities, medical schools, hospitals, and research institutions throughout the country and abroad. Research grant applications submitted to NIH must go through a two-step review process that includes the initial peer review for scientific and technical merit and a second step of review and approval by a National Advisory Council for program relevance. In addition, prior to an award or funding being made, NIH staff must conduct an administrative review for a number of other considerations. These include alignment with NIH’s funding principles, review of the project budget, assessment of the applicant’s management systems, determination of applicant eligibility, and compliance with public policy requirements. After all these steps have been completed, NIH officials make funding decisions on individual grant applications.
