The Advisory Board was designed to develop collaborative and innovative approaches to improve the quality of, including preventing abuse, neglect, and exploitation in, long-term care. In these matters, the Advisory Board would secure, directly from any Federal department or agency, such information as the advisory board considered

necessary to carry out its activities, and request from any entity pursuing elder justice activities under the Elder Justice Act of 2009 or an amendment made by that act any data, reports or recommendations generated in connection with such activities.

**20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?**

The legislation prescribed that the Advisory Board be composed of 27 members appointed by the Secretary, HHS from among members of the general public who are individuals with experience and expertise in elder abuse, neglect, and exploitation prevention, detection, treatment, intervention, or prosecution.

It is recommended that this committee terminate, as no funds have been appropriated to convene the group.
