The Personal Care Attendants Workforce Advisory Panel is HHS's statutory public advisory body on personal care attendant workforce issues related to the Community Living Assistance Services and Supports (CLASS) Act in the Affordable Care Act. The Committee was envisioned to provide advice and guidance on issues related to the adequacy of the number of personal care attendant workers, the salaries, wages, and benefits, and access to the services provided by personal care attendant workers. The committee did not meet and the charter was not renewed.

According to the authorizing statute, the members were to be balanced by the statutorily required categories: Individuals with disabilities of all ages (3 nominees)Senior individuals (3 nominees)Representatives of individuals with disabilities (3 nominees)Representatives of senior individuals (1 nominee)Representatives of workforce and labor organizations (3 nominees)Representatives of home and community-based services providers (1 nominee)Representatives of assisted living providers (1 nominee)

The committee did not meet and the charter was not renewed.

Due to the decision not to proceed with implementation of the CLASS program, the committee will not meet and the charter was not renewed.

The Secretary announced on October 14, 2011 that Operating Division "Community Living Assistance Service and Support (CLASS)" would not be created because of budget constraints. The DFO said he wanted to be consistent with her announcement, and the committee never had a meeting. In FY-2019, this committee was recommended for termination by HHS to OMB under Executive Order 13875.
