The Personal Care Attendants Workforce Advisory Panel is HHS's statutory public advisory body on personal care attendant workforce issues related to the Community Living Assistance Services and Supports (CLASS) Act in the Affordable Care Act. The Committee was envisioned to provide advice and guidance on issues related to the adequacy of

the number of personal care attendant workers, the salaries, wages, and benefits, and access to the services provided by personal care attendant workers. The committee did not meet and the charter was not renewed.

The DFO said he wanted to be consistent with her announcement, and the committee never had a meeting.
