Membership will consist of representatives of those departments and agencies specified in section 3(a) of Executive Order 13549 and non-Federal Government representatives of SLTPS entities as nominated by Committee members and approved by the Chairman. The non-Federal members to the SLTPS-PAC will initially be nominated by the Federal members, as the designation of Federal members is specified by the Order. Once there are non-Federal members on the committee, those members may nominate other individuals for membership.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The committee shall meet at least twice annually.
