20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

Congress clearly defined in Section 491 (c) of the Higher Education Act, as amended, that the membership of the Committee shall be composed of 11 members of which four shall be appointed by the leaders of the Senate, two each upon recommendation by the majority and minority; four

by the leaders of the House of Representatives, two each upon recommendation by the majority and the minority; and three by the Secretary of Education, one of whom must be a student. Therefore, to ensure that the Committee membership remains diverse and balanced, Congress and the Secretary have appointed a broad range of members from a geographically and professionally diverse financial aid community to serve a single term of four years in order to provide independent and objective technical analysis of important student aid issues.
