GTAC will address current industry and Federal travel trends and provide advice and recommendations to GSA for improvements to increase travel efficiency and effectiveness, reduce costs, promote sustainability, and incorporate industry best practices.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

GTAC will be comprised of no more than 15 members, including the Chair. Members may include Federal agency travel managers, hoteliers, rental car companies, airline companies, travel and lodging associations, convention and visitor bureaus, state and local Government representatives, as well as corporations.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

GTAC will meet approximately 12 times during a 12-month period. The meetings will be held electronically.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

GTAC will aid GSA in moving towards more cost-effective travel solutions. It provides an opportunity for travel industry leaders and other qualified individuals to offer their expert advice and recommendations to GSA. GSA is responsible for the development and implementation of the Federal Travel Regulation which prescribes policies for travel by civilian employees and others authorized to travel at Government expense.
