It is anticipated that the Committee will observe market developments regarding the freedom and openness of the Internet and will focus in particular on issues addressed in the FCC's Open Internet rules, such as transparency, reasonable network management practices, differences in treatment of fixed and mobile broadband services, specialized services, technical standards, and the state of competition.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

Members will represent the interests of consumer advocates; Internet engineering experts; content, application, and service providers; network equipment and end-user-device manufacturers and suppliers; investors; broadband service providers; and others as appropriate. Members will be selected to balance the viewpoints that are necessary to address effectively the issues to be considered by the OIAC. No members of the OIAC or its subcommittees or working groups shall be registered lobbyists under the Lobbying Disclosure Act.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

Two to three meetings per year. No meetings were held during FY 2011, as the committee was being organized.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

The OIAC is necessary to track and evaluate the effects of the Commission's Open Internet rules through committee deliberation and recommendations.

20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings? No OIAC meetings were closed.

The OIAC was terminated by the FCC early in FY 2015.
