industry, labor unions, medical organizations, and environmental concerns. Members agreed upon scientific validity of AEGL values as the overriding goal to establish scientifically sound chemical emergency programs that protect human health through valid prediction of vulnerability (hazard) zones. This enabled legitimate focusing of emergency response during a chemical accident.

The NAC/AEGL previously completed its work and terminated September 30, 2011. The NAC/AEGL did not meet in in fiscal year 2011.
