The MAC has recommended examination and development of web based tools to notify State and local DOT's of road hazards of concern to motorcyclists. The MAC has recommended the sites incorporate functionality to provide riders with this information until repairs are affected. This project is ongoing. RoadHazard.org is a benchmark site that provides this service to Florida, Indiana, Illinois and Ohio.The MAC has shown interest and recommended investigation of a number of R&T issues that affect motorcyclists including: •Examining the skid resistance of intersection markings•Improving retro-reflectivity of signs and roadway markings•Considering the use of wider lane markings in order to increase visibility•Reviewing barrier designs used internationally, and identify those that are most forgiving when impacted by motorcyclists• Examining the use of various sealants on road surfaces
