20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

By submitting to Secretary Chao a report on the committee's findings and recommendations resulting from its evaluation of the Job Corps program. Specifically, the committee was asked to evaluate program characteristics, including its purpose, goals, and effectiveness, efficiency, and performance measures in order to address the critical issues facing the provision of job training and education to the youth population that it serves, particularly as related to creating a pipeline of young workers for a demand-driven workforce. The committee was also asked to provide advice the review, development, and implementation of policies, legislation, and regulations affecting Job Corps. This report was submitted on April 30, 2008.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

By the requirements of the Charter. The Committee shall consist of 16 members appointed by the Secretary as follows:(a) representatives of the employer community(b) representatives of organized labor(c) representatives of the Job Corps contractor community(d) representative of the workforce development community(e) representatives of the interests of secondary and post-secondary education, including one representative with experience in multi-cultural education and diversity(f) representative of career technical training(g) representative of the counseling and mentoring profession(h) representatives of armed forces (one service and one academy)(i) representative of the law enforcement community(j) representative of faith-based and community organizations(k) representative of the disabilities communityThe Secretary shall appoint one of the members as Chairperson to the committee. A representative of the U.S. Department of Education, U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and the U.S. Department of Justice shall be invited to serve as non-voting members of the committee ex-officio. The Deputy Secretaries of Labor, Agriculture, and Interior are non-voting ex-officio members.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

This committee fulfilled its purpose by submitting a report to Secretary Chao.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

This committee is no longer necessary.
