## 20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

Public Law 110-389 mandated the establishment of the Advisory Committee on Disability Compensation and that the Secretary regularly consults with and seeks the advice of the Committee with respect to the maintenance and periodic readjustment of the schedule for rating disabilities. This statutorily authorized Committee takes precedence; therefore this Committee was terminated because it had the same objectives and scope of activities.

### 20b. How does the Committee balance its

### membership?

Members were selected from among recognized experts, Veterans (stakeholders), and others with special competence in areas such as disability claims adjudication, vocational rehabilitation, disability programs management, workers' compensation, rehabilitative medicine, mental health research, military medical services management, Veterans' benefits advocacy, and survivor benefits advocacy.

## 20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The Committee did not meet due to the short duration and then termination of the Committee.

## 20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

Payment of disability compensation to Veterans who suffer from the effects of service connected disabilities is one of the core VA responsibilities. Proper management of the payment program is essential to the Department's business. The newly established Advisory Committee on Disability Compensation provides advice to the Secretary on establishing and supervising a schedule to conduct periodic reviews of the VA Schedule for Rating Disabilities.

# 20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

No meetings were held.

#### 21. Remarks

It should be noted that a comprehensive review of the VA Schedule for Rating Disabilties (VASRD) has been recommended by a major federal panel during the past year. That panel was a statutorily-established commission which operated as a federal advisory committee and submitted its recommendations in October 2007. A comprehensive review of the VASRD has also been discussed in various congressional hearings during the past several years.
