The TCRDSAC completed their work in fiscal year (FY) 2008 and the committee was allowed to sunset July 16, 2009. The FY 2008 product of the deliberation was an Agreement in Principle which the Committee members signed in September 2008. In fiscal year 2009 two meeting summaries were completed (December 2008). They pertained to a teleconference and meeting held in September 2008 to discuss final revisions to the Agreement in Principle. Contractor cost to complete the two meeting summaries occurred in

FY 2009.

The committee completed its work in September 2008 and did not meet in 2009.

21. Remarks

The Total Coliform Rule Distribution System Advisory Committee did not meet in FY 2009. The Committee was not renewed and sunset on July 16, 2009. Costs were incurred primarily by a contractor who completed two summary reports (minutes) in December 2008. Members were invited to serve through July 10, 2009, by EPA's Deputy Administrator, however, because the work of the committee was completed early, their terms were shortened to officially end December 31, 2009. All members are Tier 1 (parent committee members). There are no Tier 2 (subcommittee) members serving.
