The Committee will update NOAA on the progress during the development of the CCSP Synthesis and Assessment Product for topic 3.3 and will agree upon the contents of the product before advising NOAA to adopt the language.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

Members will be appointed to assure a balanced representation of scientific views among preeminent scientists, educators, and experts reflecting the full scope of the scientific issues addressed in CCSP Synthesis and Assessment Product 3.3.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The Committee's only FY08 meeting preceded submission of the final draft document for Administration approval. During its lifetime prior to FY08, the Committee held three open meetings. These focused on the development of draft document contents and the preparation of responses to public and peer review comments. These meetings were critical to the production of a comprehensive and balanced final document.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

This Committee is essential so that the Secretary of Commerce can comply with duties imposed on the Department, including the Global Change Research Act of 1990 (P.L. No. 101-606, Section 106). There is no other source available to provide this information.
