Membership shall include those with demonstrated ability to represent minorities, women, and persons with disabilities.

The USDA Technology and eGovernment Adivsory Council is essential because USDA invests over \$2 billion annually on information technology solutions that support program delivery. This council will fill this need by consulting with and incorporating into our plans expert advice from the cutomers, partners, and employees. This will result in improved technology management.
