20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

Congress created the ARMS initiative in the National Defense Authorization Act for FY '93, P.L. 102-484. The FY 93 Appropriations Conference Committee then directed the Secretary of the Army to establish a public/private task force to make recommendations on the permanent structure and implementaton of the Armament Retooling and Manufacturing Support Initiative. However, since that time, various other Committees' recommendations affect the issues, concerns, and progress made within the ARMS

arena, so there is no longer a need for this Committee. ARMS was disestablished on 15 July 2005 with DoD concurrence in Memo dated 24 August 2005.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

Revised ethics guidance precluded representatives from SGEs. DA/DOD guidance stated that all members of DA/DOD FACAs must be SGE's; therefore the ability for the forum to continue was greatly hindered. ARMS was disestablished on 15 July 2005 with DoD concurrence in Memo dated 24 August 2005.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

In an October 2004 meeting, it was decided that the ARMS EAC should be allowed to expire on 16 July 2005, when the Charter expired. ARMS was officially disestablished on 15 July 2005 with DoD concurrence in Memo dated 24 August 2005.

No meetings were held in FY '04. Committee has had difficulty getting qualified members to serve. Issue was re-looked in October 2004 (FY '05) and Committee was officially disestablished upon termination of its charter on July 15, 2005. not reflected for FY '05 because committee is no longer needed and was terminated.
