They are: (1)certifying organizations; (2) research and education organizations; (3) education and membership organizations which represent the interest of practitioners; (4) industry and business organizations, such as manufacturers or facilities; (5) Medicare beneficiaries; (6) representatives of various state entities and (7) a miscellaneous category.
