-- by providing recommendations on a public dedication ceremony for the Battle of Midway National Memorial and on long-term management strategies for the Memorial.-- by working with Service officials to improve interpretation and exhibits on the Battle of Midway.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

Members represent the National Park Service; Department of the Navy; International Midway Memorial Foundation, Inc.; Sixth Defense Battalion, USMC; National Trust for Historic Preservation; National Wildlife Refuge Association; Friends of Midway Atoll National Wildlife Refuge; and the Battle of Midway veterans' community. All members share an interest in preserving Midway's history.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

No meetings were held in Fiscal Year 2004 due to FWS staffing and funding issues, uncertainties related to future management of the National Memorial, and the need to revise the committee charter and membership.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

The Committee was required by the Secretary's Order establishing the Battle of Midway National Memorial. In the authorizing legislation (within the Fiscal Year 2000 Interior Appropriations Act), the Secretary was required to consult with interested veterans' organizations and others to determine management of the Memorial.

20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings? Meetings are not closed.

21. Remarks

The Fish and Wildlife Service recommends this Committee be terminated at this time, with the hope that it can be rechartered in the future. Funding to operate Midway Atoll National Wildlife Refuge and the Battle of Midway National Memorial has not been secured for Fiscal Year 2005 at this time. Future uncertainties make it difficult for any Committee to make appropriate recommendations at this time.
