## 20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

The National Advisory Committee on Children and Terrorism assessed and provided recommendations regarding (a) the preparedness of the health care (including mental health care) system to respond to bioterrorism as it relates to children; (b) needed changes to the health care and emergency medical service systems and emergency medical services protocols to meet the special needs of children; and (c) changes, if necessary, to the National Strategic Stockpile under section 121 of the Public Health Security and Bioterrorism Preparedness and Response Act of 2002 to meet the emergency health security of children.

### 20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

Members were selected from among nominees who were child health experts on infectious disease, environmental health, toxicology, and other relevant professional disciplines. Close attention was given to equitable geographic distribution and to ethnic/racial minority and female representation.

### 20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

Three meetings were held.

### 20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

The committee was specifically mandated by the Public Health Security and Bioterrorism Preparedness and Response Act of 2002 to make recommendations to the Secretary on matters related to bioterrorism and its impact on children. Neither the Department nor any of its existing committees can feasibly perform these duties.
