They represent the fields of law, entrepreneurs, trade associations, academia, large business, hotel management, and banking. This mix has been successful in bringing various viewpoints and expertise to the Council.

Meetings are held quarterly. The Council should continue because the members provide us with different viewpoints about the Agency and the effectiveness of our programs.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

The diversity of the fields represented has been essential in giving us access to various segments of the business community, which has assisted us in our marketing and outreach efforts in the Washington metropolitan area.

20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

All meetings are open to the public.

21. Remarks

No formal meetings were held during FY 2002. During the year we experienced turnover three times in the District Director position, which did not provide adequate time to schedule meetings where the District Director could attend. Each person in that position did meet with the Chairperson of the Advisory Council and several members individually, but not the Council as a whole. Since March 1, 2002, our district director made a decision to revamp the Council with a new

membership. Beginning in FY 2003, meetings will be scheduled.
