## 20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

Per its Charter, the Advisory Group will meet approximately three times a year to provide the Attorney General and the NDPO general and practical policy advice regarding NDPO program strategy development and implementation. This advice is in support of the NDPO's goal to enhance the capabilities of emergency responders and medical professionals at all levels to safely and effectively respond to potential or actual terrorist acts involving weapons of mass destruction (WMD).

## 20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

The Advisory Group reflects a balanced representation of perspectives and interests from the emergency response community. The 32-member Advisory Group has representatives from fire/rescue, HAZMAT, emergency medical and health services, law enforcement, emergency management, and state and local governments. Criteria guiding the selection inluded:A. Demonstrated background and interest in the issue of domestic preparedness, particularly in the area of WMD terrorism preparedness;B. Balance, with regard to point of view or professional perspective;C. Nondiscrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, age, sex, or sexual orientation; andD. Geographical balance.

## 20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

In FY 2001, no meetings were held. Nevertheless, per the charter, the Advisory Group should meet three times per year, and the NDPO regards input from the state and local emergency response community as essential to NDPO program initiatives.

## 20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

As stated above, input from the state and local emergency response community is critical to the NDPO, and the Advisory Group is an efficient means of obtaining this input.

## 20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

To date, there have been no closed meetings.
