The President's Council on the Use of Offsets in Commercial Trade is a federally chartered advisory committee established by Executive Order 13177. Its purpose is to review and report to the President, through the Director of the Office of Management and Budget, on the use of offsets in commercial trade, including their impact on the U.S. defense and commercial industrial base.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

The Council consists of the same 11 members who are appointed to be members of the parallel National Commission on the Use of Offsets

inDefense Trade established by section 1247 of Public Law 106-113. Membership is made up of members from the private sector, academia, and the executive branch, including Office of Management and Budget, Departments of Commerce, Defense, State, and Labor.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

Meetings shall occur at least once per year.

This committee consists of members who have recognized expertise in international economics, and was established by Executive Order.
