The DNA Advisory Board represents a broad, well-balanced combination of points of view on DNA matters, from the legal, forensic, technical, statistical, law enforcement and ethical perspectives. Members of this Board include: scientists from federal, state and local public forensic laboratories; private laboratories; and the National Institute of Standards and Technology, as well as a bioethicist; a Supreme Court Justice and a population and molecular geneticists.

The DNA Advisory Board holds approximately four meetings a year.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

The DNA Advisory Board is statutorily authorized and mandated to make recommendations concerning minimum standards for laboratories performing forensic DNA analysis.
