State-owned lands to the Secretary of the Interior.)

(1) Re #6 (EXPECTED CHARTER RENEWAL DATE) -- Pursuant to the committee's enabling legislation, the FACA Setion 14(b) biennial rechartering requirement has been waived for the committee. (2) Re ACTIVATION OF THE COMMITTEE --The Poverty Point National Monument was established by P.L. 100-560. NPS' authority to administer the area is contingent upon acquisition of State-owned land which has not occurred. The site is still managed by the State of Louisiana. The land donation has not yet transpired. Consequently, though a charter was filed for the advisory committee on May 17, 1990, no members have been appointed.
