The Committee met in 1998, in open session, and with the help of a facilitator, and in accordance with rules outlined by Executive Order 13061, evaluated and discussed 116 applications from river communities, held straw votes, and concluded with an announcement (and report) of 10 rivers recommended for designation as American Heritage Rivers. As prescribed by the E.O., this committee was terminated during FY-2000.

# 20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

The President hand picked members from different geographic areas, with varied experience

and expertise in the areas of environment, historic preservation, business and economics, Tribal relations, and water resources issues and projects.

# 20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

No meetings were held in FY-2000.

# 20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

The President wanted to ensure that a diverse group of experts, from across the country, with varied backgrounds and experience, and from different gender and racial groups, was assembled to make these important recommendations. The Committee, composed of unpaid (except travel reimbursement) volunteers, was necessary to ensure a fair and objective review of nominations, and to eliminate perceptions that the results were driven by Federal agency agendas or politics.
