20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

The Committee was established to advise the Secretary of the Interior on matters relating to the management and development of Natchez National Historical Park. All members of the Commission were interested in history and historic preservation and a ready source of information on restoration of park resources and on the location of historic references.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

The Committee was composed of six members appointed by the Secretary of the Interior, as follows: (a) two members appointed from recommendations by the Mayor of Natchez; (b)

one member appointed from recommendations by the Governor of Mississippi; (c) two members having expertise in historic preservation to represent the historic preservation community; and (d) one member having expertise in architectural history to represent the architectural community.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

No meetings of the Commission were held for the 4-5 years prior to its termination. Meetings were no longer necessary when the long range planning for the development of park resources had been completed.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

The Commission served an important role in the early planning and developing of the Park, and its purpose has been met. In accordance with its charter, the Natchez National Historical Park Advisory Commission terminated on October 7, 1998.

20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

All meetings were open.
