HRSA is undergoing strategic changes in mission and program activities, as well as internal administrative streamlining. It is imperative that the Administrator have available to him the thought and recommendations of experts in public health, administration and policy development. It is therefore a priority for the Administrator to organize an advisory committee to serve in an advisory capacity.
