20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

The secretary of Agriculture and the Cheif of the Forest Service will use the findings and recommendations of the Task Force where and when appropriate to Departmental and Agency policy issues so arise. At this time, there are no specific plans that would incorporate the majority or minority views expressed in the final report. Some problems identified during the course of the public meetings conducted by the Task Force have already been resolbed by the Forest Service actions undertaken after the meetings were held.

# 20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

Of the 7 memebers of this task forcem the Republican leadership of the House and Senate apponted 4 members, the Democratic leadership apponted 2 members and the Secretary of Agriculture appointed 1 member. All 7 reside in the West; 6 men and 1 woman, 2 are in academia and 2 are in private law practices, 1 is in a public interest group, and 2 serve as executive Directors of private water associations. Four members were pro-water development interests and opposed public acquisition of water rights to protect the environment. Three members were diametrically opposed to the four members just described in philosophy and conclusions reached at the end of their year long serach for compromise. The task force struggled with many side issues, heard from over 60 witnesses from all points of view, appeared ready to find a compromise, but it all unraveled in the last 2 meetings. The report was written in part by all members, with chairman views representing the majority, and the Vice-Chairman's views included in the Chapter titled Separate Views in the back of the report.

## **Committee Meetings?**

The committee held 11 meetings during this fiscal yaear in various cities in the West. Most were 1 or 2 days long. One meeting was held in Washington, DC Meetings were used to solicit ideas from the public and the congress on how to resolve the five questions assigned to the task force by the statute. A very thorough investigation was conducted, the iissues wwere debated at great length by the task force members, and in the end no resolution was found fro the major issue given tothe task force to solve. Continuing it would serve no useful purpose and the members themselves are glad it is over and they can return to their normal professional lives.

# 20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

The statute required this task force be appointed, asigned it five questions to address, set a deadline for the final report to the Congress and the Secretary.
