The Board shall consist of not more than 25 members appointed by the President. The Board shall include the Secretary, the Executive Director of the Initiative and representatives of a variety of

sectors, such as: (i) philanthropy;(ii) education;(iii) business;(iv) finance;(v) entrepreneurship;(vi) innovation;(vii) private foundations; and(viii) sitting HBCU presidents. The President shall designate one member of the Board to serve as Chair.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

At least once every six months.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

The Board consisted of representatives of a variety of sectors to advise on (i) improving the identity, visibility, distinctive capabilities, and overall competitiveness of HBCUs; (ii) engaging the philanthropic, business, government, military, homeland security, and education communities in a national dialogue regarding new HBCU programs and initiatives; (iii) improving the ability of HBCUs to remain fiscally secure institutions that can assist the Nation in achieving its educational goals and in advancing the interests of all Americans; (iv) elevating the public awareness of, and fostering appreciation of, HBCUs; and (v) encouraging public-private investments in HBCUs.
