The Committee will provide information and advice regarding the development of the management plan and, as appropriate, management of the Monument to the Secretary of the Interior, through the Director of BLM, and the Secretary of Agriculture through the Chief of the U.S. Forest Service (FS) as stated in the Presidential Proclamation establishing the Monument.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

The Committee shall include up to 15 members to be appointed by the Secretary of the Interior and the Secretary of Agriculture from the following broad spectrum of interests to ensure balanced membership: San Juan County; state government; paleontology; archaeology; environment; grazing; tribal interests; developed outdoor recreation; dispersed recreation; private landowners; local business owners; and the public at large.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The Committee will meet approximately two to four times annually.

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

Presidential Proclamation 9558 of 2016 establishing the Bears Ears National Monument also required the establishment of a FACA-chartered advisory committee to provide information and advice regarding the development of the management plan and, as appropriate, management of the monument.
