20a. How does the Committee accomplish its purpose?

Pursuant to section 550B(c)(2) of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2020 ("the FY 2020 NDAA"), the Defense Advisory Committee for the Prevention of Sexual Misconduct (DAC PSM) shall review, on an ongoing basis, the following: a) Closed cases involving allegations of sexual assault described in § 550B(c)(1) of the FY 2020 NDAA. b) Efforts of institutions of higher education to prevent sexual assault among students. c) Any other information

or matters that the committee or the Secretary of Defense considers appropriate. In addition to the reviews required by § 550B(c)(2) of the FY 2020 NDAA, for purposes of providing advice to the Secretary of Defense, the DAC PSM shall also consult and coordinate with the Defense Advisory Committee on Investigation, Prosecution, and Defense of Sexual Assault in the Armed Forces on matters of joint interest to the two advisory committees as directed by § 550B(c)(3) of the FY 2020 NDAA.

20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

In accordance with § 550B(b) of the FY 2020 NDAA, the DAC PSM shall consist of not more than 20 members, appointed by the Secretary of Defense from among individuals who have an expertise appropriate for the work of the DAC PSM, including at least one individual with each expertise as follows: a) Expertise in the prevention of sexual assault and behaviors on the sexual assault continuum of harm. b) Expertise in adverse behaviors, including the prevention of suicide and the prevention of substance abuse. c) Expertise in the change of culture of large organizations. d) Expertise in implementation science.

20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

An estimated 2 meetings per year to meet Department requirements and to address sponsor-approved studies

20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere? Required by statute.

20e. Why is it necessary to close and/or partially closed committee meetings?

Meetings are not closed to the public unless the Department of Defense determines that items on the planned agenda meet the closed-meeting provisions of 5 U.S.C. § 552b(c). Pursuant to DoD policy closed meetings can only be authorized by the DoD Sponsor, who is the Under Secretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness, and only after consultation with the appropriate General Counsel.

21. Remarks

In FY23, the DAC-PSM submitted one report with a total of 16 recommendations for Department consideration. Additionally, in accordance with subsection 550B(d) of the FY 2020 NDAA, as amended by sections 534 and 535 of the FY 2021 NDAA, not later than March 30th of each year, the DAC-PSM shall submit a report on the activities of the DAC-PSM during the preceding year to the DoD Appointing Authority, the Committees on Armed Services and Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate and the Committees on Armed Services and Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of Representatives. Dr. Victoria L. Banyard's term start date was incorrectly reported in the FY22 ACR as August 1, 2022 vice the correct term start date of July 27, 2022.

L. 92–463). The DAC-PSM has a mandate to provide the Secretary of Defense and Congress with independent advice and recommendations on matters relating to the prevention of sexual misconduct in the DoD. The National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2021 (FY21 NDAA) expanded the DAC-PSM's scope to include the United States Coast Guard Academy.
