To advise the Committee on matters relating to national oceanographic science, engineering, facilities, or resource requirements. c. To advise the Committee on improving diversity, equity, and inclusion in the ocean sciences and related fields. d. To advise the Committee on national ocean research priorities. e. Any additional

responsibilities that the Committee considers appropriate.

## 20b. How does the Committee balance its membership?

Per the legislation the ORAP membership shall be made up of the following: a. Three members who represent the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine. b. Members selected from among individuals who represent the views of ocean industries, state, tribal, territorial, or local governments, academia, and such other views as the Committee Co-Chairs consider appropriate. c. Members selected from among individuals eminent in the fields of marine science, marine technology, marine policy, or related fields. The Committee shall ensure that an appropriate balance of academic, scientific, industry, and geographical interests and gender and racial diversity are represented by the members of the Panel.

## 20c. How frequent and relevant are the Committee Meetings?

The Panel will meet approximately three times each year but not less than two times each year. Additional meetings may be called as deemed desirable by the Committee.

# 20d. Why can't the advice or information this committee provides be obtained elsewhere?

The ORAP is mandated by legislation and so advice can only be provided by this committee.
